DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET NOVENA

A novena is typically nine days of prayer in preparation of a celebration of a feast day. **The Chaplet of Divine Mercy** can be said anytime, but the Lord specifically asked that it be recited as a **Novena beginning on Good Friday and ending on the Saturday before the Feast of Mercy (Divine Mercy Sunday on April 12, 2026).** He promised, “*I am love and mercy itself. ... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. ... My mercy is greater than your sins, and those of the entire world. By this Novena (of Chaplets), I will grant every possible grace to souls.*”
