and the sacrament of reconciliation (confession) regularly.

A Christian Witness			
A person who is baptized in a non-Roman Catholic community (ie. Anglican, United, Presbyterian) may be a Christian witness as long as a Catholic godparent is also present.  When two people are asked to be godparents or Christian witness, they are to be male and female. If you are not sure whether a person is a suitable candidate, please consult the Parish Office before asking that person.			
Catholics who were baptized Catholic, but are now practicing another faith <i>may not</i> act as Christian witness or godparent.

<u>Canon 873</u>: - There is to be only one male or one female godparent or one of each.

- At least 16 years of age
- Fully initiated in the Catholic Church (received Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation)
- In good standing with the Church (e.g. has not married outside the Catholic Church; not cohabitating)
- Not a parent of the one being baptized

<ul> <li>One godparent <u>OR</u> one godfather and one godmother - MUST be Baptized and Confirmed Roman Catholics.</li> <li>A Roman Catholic who has been Baptized and Confirmed and a Christian (who is non-Catholic) who may act as Witness, who takes the place of either the godfather <u>OR</u> godmother, but not both.</li> </ul>
