The renovation / restoration project began in 2017 and was completed in 2020. The project involved new church entrance steps, replace boilers, upgraded fire door hardware, asbestos removal, restoration of Church and Rectory facades, east retaining wall, as well as a new Rectory parking lot and landscaping. The total cost of the renovation / restoration project was financed by the Archdiocese from funds raised and segregated by the Family of Faith campaign to rehabilitate old historical churches. Currently, the advances are interest free.
